

EEO PUBLIC FILE REPORT
(For Reporting Period May 1, 2016 through May 31, 2016)

This EEO Public File Report is prepared by AMC Partners, LLC (“AMC”) for the Station Employment Unit made up of the following radio stations: WUPF, Powers, Michigan (FCC Facility ID No. 164245); WUPG, Republic, Michigan (FCC Facility ID No. 164246); WUPT, Gwinn, Michigan (FCC Facility ID No. 164244); and WUPZ, Chocolay Township, Michigan (FCC Facility ID No. 164243) (collectively the “UP SEU”).

On May 1, 2016, AMC commenced providing programming for the stations in the UP SEU pursuant to a local programming and marketing agreement (“LMA”) between AMC and RadioActive, LLC, the licensee of the stations in the UP SEU. Thus, this Report covers only one month of the normal 12-month reporting period.

With respect to hiring and recruitment, when the LMA commenced, AMC retained five full-time employees who had been employed with the stations in the UP SEU by the party that previously provided programming for the stations. A sixth full-time employee was transferred from a separate SEU consisting of radio stations licensed to AMC’s wholly owned subsidiary, AMC Partners Escanaba, LLC (“AMC Escanaba”).¹

Some of the radio stations licensed to AMC Escanaba have overlapping contours with some of the radio stations in the UP SEU, and thus are in the same local non-Nielsen-rated radio market. Out of an abundance of caution, and pursuant to Section 73.2080(f)(3), this initial EEO Public File Report of AMC is being included in the Form 397 Mid-term Report to be filed by AMC Escanaba, even though the UP SEU has less than 10 full-time employees.

With the commencement of the LMA one month ago, AMC has not yet engaged in outreach initiatives for the stations in the SEU pursuant to Section 73.2080(c)(2) of the FCC’s rules.
